Elegant early 18th century German cabinet, circa 1720, made from a combination of noble woods such as walnut, olive, ebony and cherry. This piece of furniture embodies the craftsmanship of the Baroque period, distinguished by its complex structure and refined decoration. Upper Section: The upper section of the cabinet features eight large side drawers, which can be automatically locked by operating two levers hidden inside the central compartment, protected by a lockable door. In addition, four additional small drawers are located in the upper section, providing additional storage space. Middle Section: The central section features a drop-leaf door that, when opened, reveals a charming desk decorated with red leather. The edge of the desk is decorated with a gold frieze with four fleur-de-lis
