Rare Louis XV period solid silver champagne curon with a plain body with fillets under the neck and engraved "NM". Countermarks (crowned tower and crowned fleur-de-lys) of the Sous-Fermier of SAINTE-MENEHOULD noted from 1746 to 1775, Common House Hallmark for SAINTE-MENEHOULD circa 1764-66 (Crowned L) and Hallmark of Master Goldsmith Jean-Joachim JOUETTE received in 1759. Champagne curon in good general condition and remarkably hallmarked, also revised and cleaned by our goldsmith, micro-scratches from use. For the informed collector ...
