Inscription under the base Made in France In perfect condition Weight 8.8 kg Neck Ø 27.5 cm David GUERON known as DEGUE (1892-1950) took over an old glassworks-crystalworks in Compiègne (Oise), specializing in perfume bottles which called: "SA Cristalleries de Compiègne". In the same year, he founded the "Verrerie d'Art Degué" at 63 boulevard Malherbes in Paris (factory) and acquired premises at 41 rue de Paradis in the 10th
