Description

This exquisite 19th century Majolica porcelain sculpture depicts a nude girl in a boat. This small figurine, measuring 8 cm high, 12.8 cm wide and 9.8 cm deep, displays remarkable attention to detail and artistry. The subtlety of the half-tone colours lends an extraordinary level of realism to the girl's body and face. Even the most minute details, such as the eyelashes and eyebrows, are carefully drawn and can be appreciated under a strong magnifying glass. The maker of this masterpiece is not clearly identified, with an indiscernible printing stamp affixed to the bottom of the work. Its style is similar to Royal Worcester or Minton majolica, with the pink colour of the base leaning more towards Minton. However, it could also be the work of French artisans. I have never encountered a piece of this
