The candelabras and sconces all have matching hallmarks for Sheffield 1964 with the silversmiths marks EV for Emile Viner . They are in excellent condition with no damage or repairs (any marks you can see are just reflections) and have a super decoration of acanthus leaves on the sconces and urns around the bases.
