The gold color is reminiscent of antique bronze. Vase decorated with pink flowers mixed with gold patterns on the outer and inner sides. The base consists of a ribbed metal frame with four feet painted in the noble color of antique bronze. Beautiful and rare European piece in the style of the Dresden masters. Early Dresden porcelain is known for its finely detailed and brightly colored painted scenes, often decorated with gilding.
