This engraving is titled "Revue du Quintidi"; under the portrait of the 1st Consul, a large military review is being held in the courtyard of the Tuileries Palace, with that of the Louvre in the background. ("Revue du Quintidi" on the 5th day of the week at the Tuileries Palace, 29 Thermidor, Year X (August 17, 1802).
