A very pretty antique Victorian sterling silver and bone-handled fish set for twelve people, having hand-engraved blades and tines with floral decoration, and fitted into their original dark blue velvet and satin-lined walnut presentation box. All made by Hammond, Creake & Co, Sheffield in 1900. The dimensions of these fine hand-made antique silver fish-eaters are length of knife 21.5 cms (8.5 inches), and fork 18.5 cms (7.25 inches). The serving knife is 31 cms (12 inches) the serving fork is 23.5 cm (9 1/4 inches) long. The condition is very good one bone handle is discoloured slightly but this has no damage or any repairs. A fine set ready for immediate use.
