Atypical and rare Katana from the Showa period with its Mumei blade (unsigned) with double grooves and its Koshirae. Selling price (Excluding shipping costs) This Katana blade is very well preserved, without any particular forging defect, but with some small oxidation spots and 3 scratches (see photos). The Koshirae is composed of a modern Saya and a modern Tsuka.
