## Description

ANTHROPOMORPHE STATUTE with bent legs, her feet forming a trapezoidal base, characteristic of the culture.

His hands rest on his knees, which are themselves folded over a bulging belly with a prominent umbilicus. His stylised face is punctuated by a goatee, two small lateral protuberances referring to his ears or short plaits and a horizontal eyebrow arch in relief.

It probably represents an ancestor.
