Superb and very rare piece of furniture from the Charles X period. This is a hybrid piece of furniture, most certainly custom-made by a seasoned cabinetmaker. It is a console topped with a drop-leaf secretary in mahogany burl veneer, rosewood and light wood fillets. Interior of the secretary in lemonwood and rosewood. High quality marquetry of the fillets with a perfect match between the console and the secretary in the corners and the ogee. The proportions of this piece of furniture are perfect for it to fit into a living room as well as a bedroom. The console has slightly crooked jambs with a marquetry panel with a star of the winds at the bottom. Even the small melon feet are marquetry. This console opens with a large drawer in a band. The secretary part has a mirror
