France. July Monarchy. Firefighter officer's helmet. Entirely in brass.- The base of the bomb is bordered at the front and back by a band decorated with moldings in relief at the front and back. Movable visor stamped in relief with two crossed axes linked together by a ribbon framed by laurel branches. Neck cover encircled with a reed folded astride its outer edge. Crest with fins stamped with ten gadroons with a mask decorated with a flaming bomb, it is topped with a black horsehair caterpillar. Front plate in brass stamped with a Gallic rooster on a globe placed on a shield marked "devotion", framed by branches of vines and sheaves of wheat, with a ribbon bearing the inscription "SAPEURS POMPIERS DE GHAINTEY" on a background of a bundle of flags. Brass chin straps composed of two chin
