Two gilded bronze birds adorn the clock Its enameled dial bears the brand Courvoisier A.Paris, a watchmaker referenced in the Tardy, dictionary of French watchmakers. Original wire movement that works Set in very good condition Dimensions of the clock: Height: 65 cm Width 37 cm \*Adrien-Jérôme Jollain Received Master cabinetmaker on August 1, 1763 He belonged to a family of watchmakers, he mainly produced clock cases. He was established in the cloister of Saint John Lateran. Died around 1788.
