



English Coat Of Arms, Watercolour Circa 1840



Description

Large watercolor enhanced with gold around 1840, representing the coat of arms of the Crolly family, with the motto "Malo mori quam foedari ", surmounted by a hat and a haume which complete the inscription of the family in a distant medieval past. Good frame, certainly made about twenty years ago with a 19th century battery and a pretty gray pass beveled with gold. The paper being 19th century, it has yellowed a little, but the colors are very fresh.
