Philippe Rochette-Castel (1941-2023), very pretty and important pocket emptier, which can be used as a planter, in ceramic enameled in shades of blue depicting a fish very inspired by the style of the creations of Eugène Viollet-le-Duc (1814-1879). A student at the École des Beaux-Arts in Paris, Philippe Rochette-Castel, painter and sculptor, produced works during the second half of the 20th century and the beginning of the 21st century. He was chosen several times for state commissions. This very pretty ceramic piece, signed with his monogram intaglio in the material and dated (20)09 is a reflection of his talent.

Good condition. No shock or crack. We just note a small enamel jump at the base of the piece, almost invisible and without any impact on the Dealer
