Elegant portrait of a man in his library by Jean Beauduin, born in 1851 in Verviers and died in 1916 in Paris, A Belgian painter graduate of the Royal Academy of Fine Arts in Antwerp, he exhibited at the Salon in Paris from 1888. Our signed portrait dated 1899 at the turn of the century, a last testimony of the 19th century before the 20th. oil on canvas 41 x 33 cm in its original frame in molded natural wood: the Marie Louise in heart stripes and fine gold edging, the exterior surrounded by a row of pearls. External dimensions: 60 x 52 condition: very good condition, old small accident without seriousness, canvas and painting in good state of conservation
