Description

Large Egyptomania lounge of the Parvis house, composed of 2 benches 2 places each and 4 armchairs.

Freely inspired by the furniture discovered in the royal tombs or by the representations of the temples and papyrus, this lounge is richly decorated with heads and paws of cat on the armrests and the feet; almost each piece of wood is decorated with a marquetry in bone and wood The backs are surmounted by a frieze of Uraeus (protective cobras), those of the sofas are also decorated with profiles of gods and vultures (symbol of the goddess Nekhbet), attributes of pharaoh.
