Small loss of cardboard at the top left (see photo of the back of the painting). Teresa Bézard-Pérate was an artist active between the 19th and 20th centuries. She is known for having participated in the Salon des Femmes Peintres et Sculpteurs, an important exhibition that highlighted the works of women artists at a time when they were often marginalized. This exhibition played a crucial role in providing a platform for women to exhibit their works and gain recognition. There is currently a growing enthusiasm for women painters of the 19th century.
