



Painting Composed Of Masonic Decorations From The Middle Of The 19th Century



Description

Set of Masonic decorations from the mid-19th century These different decorations dating from the mid-19th century were framed in the 20th century We have the Scarf or necklace in orange-pink moiré silk originally red (insolated) with gold embroidered decoration of foliage and a pelican, a silver jewel representing a square and a compass with in their center an engraved silver medal representing Minerva, standing and armed, pointing with one finger at a temple between 2 acacias We have a watch chain in chiseled silver with decoration of linked hands (beautiful chiseling) a Sword, silver tie pin, then the Apron in satin embroidered with gold thread with decoration of a temple with dome, columns, stairs surmounted by a square and a dead end, in the Center the letter M, a red 5-pointed star above
