The pendants and the square are in silver, on which we can read the following inscriptions "PRESENTED TO W.BRO. HENRY WILLIAM PAUL.PM BY THE BRETHREN OF THE BRIXTON LODGE No 1949" "IN RECOGNITION OF THE ABLE AND EFFICIENT MANNER HE HAS PERFORMED HIS DUTY AS WM FEBRUARY 1st 1941" The frame is original and the apron in perfect condition.
