The porcelain plaques are painted with floral reserves surrounded by a celestial blue background enhanced with gold in the Sèvres style. Freitels surmounting the corners, women's masks in the centre of each arch. Size: H 30 cm x W 27 cm x D 27 cm with feet (20 cm x 20 cm vases only). Paris, Napoleon III period.
