Dimensions: width 44cm Johannes Andersen born in 1903 in Denmark. After his studies in cabinetmaking, he obtained his diploma and then worked for various furniture factories and publishers... In the 1930s, he created his own architecture and design workshop but began, in addition to his own company, to collaborate with various Swedish, Danish and Norwegian companies such as Trensum, CFC Silkeborg, Brahmin and Udlum Mobelfabik... Johannes Andersen took advantage of his success in the 1950s/60s: to create furniture of high quality in terms of materials and manufacturing combined with innovative functionality... First
