"Jean-Paul Jappé, born in Lorient in 1936, studied art at the École des Beaux-Arts in Quimper, where he practiced ceramics in Pierre Toulhoat's class. Invited by his teacher, with whom he maintained a friendly relationship, he created some original ceramics in the workshops of the Keraluc factory. He then completed his training in Paris at the Académie Charpentier and then at the École des Métiers d'Art. Returning to
