Description

A late 18th to early 19th century Dutch marquetry-inlaid center table of exceptional quality. This exquisite table features an overhanging rectangular top above a frieze with a shaped apron all round. It remains on four walnut bold barley twist legs that transition into cube forms, leading to an ebonized H-platform stretcher, and stands on ebonized bun feet. The quality of the decoration is truly exceptional. The frieze, top, and even the center of the stretcher are inlaid with marquetry that is cleanly laid and beautifully designed. The top of the table incorporates a floral design, with an oval stringing in the center showcasing an urn on a decorative plinth, surrounded by large flowers and scrolling foliage, and several birds and butterflies resting on the urn. Market Square Petworth GU28 0AH features countless inlaid geometric motifs. A single oak-lined drawer spans the width of the table within the decorated apron. All surfaces, except for the legs, are decorated. The table boasts wonderful proportions, combining the boldness of the design with the intricate marquetry surfaces. This piece is inlaid with fine quality woods in many colors, showcasing a natural theme of birds, butterflies, and flowers. The workmanship and detail are exceptional.
