Primitive rapier model sword with reversed guard ring and crossguard ending at the ends in the shape of a leaf. Flattened pyramidal pommel with rivet button. Filigree fuse on iron mount. Guard ring bearing a cartouche in its center with remaining gilding. Oval type blade without punch of 86 cm. Total length: 101 cm Length to the ends of the crossguard: 22 cm Height under the guard ring: 5 cm Width of the guard ring: 10.5 cm Beautiful condition of conservation and use, in its own juice, see details in the photos.
