Anthropomorphic ridge spike representing a soldier at attention, in glazed earthenware - Country of Champagne in east of France, late 18th / early 19th century.

Wearing a tricorne and a ponytail.

Stylized turned conical body, topped with a head wearing a modeled tricorne.

Modeled arms, epaulettes and buttons.

Pink earthenware glazed with a beautiful nuanced green.

Right arm and back of the tricorne have been restored.

(Very beautiful restoration, not very visible at first glance).

This type of ridge spike is found in the Champagne region.

Height 47 cm, diameter (at the base) 19 cm.
