Jane Stanhope (1755-1824) Portrait of Jane Stanhope around the age of 15 during the reign of Louis XV. Lady Harrington became famous for her fashion sense and physical attractiveness; she and Georgiana Cavendish, Duchess of Devonshire, were named "the best dressed ladies" at a party hosted by the Duchess in September 1782. In 1794, she became a lady-in-waiting to Charlotte of Mecklenburg-Strelitz, wife of King George III. Highly favoured by Queen Charlotte, Lady Harrington was a lady-in-waiting until the Queen's death in 1818. French school of the 18th century. Inscribed on the back of the stretcher "École de Nattier" and "Jane Countess of Harrington". Jane's pose is studied from the
