A Burmantofts Faience Barbotine Vase, decorated with white clematis flowers and green and brown leaves on a yellow-to-brown background. This rare and highly sought-after piece dates back to the late 19th century and bears the early Burmantofts Faience mark along with a 1490 pattern mark.

Burmantofts Leeds is a highly collectible English Art Pottery from the late 19th and early 20th centuries. The Burmantofts factory was in production in Leeds only from 1882 to 1904.

Dimensions: 40.5 cm tall, 24 cm diameter at the widest point, 4,829 g weight.

Condition: Small spots of flaking around the rim, a small chip of enamel flaking on the rim of the base. otherwise in excellent condition.
