Description

Fireplace plate cast during the first half of the 18th century, in perfect condition, with the arms of Joseph Durey de Sauroy, 1677-1752, lord of Sauroy, du Terrail, Martigny-le-Comte, of the duchy-peerage of Damville, baron of Saint-André de Digoin, of la Motte Saint-Jean, and other places of Saône et Loire and Puy-De-Dôme. Squire, advisor to the King, treasurer general of the extraordinary wars in the service of the King. He obtained the title of marquis by his marriage in 1701 with Marie-Claire-Joséphine d'Estaing, 1681-1770, daughter of Jean d'Estaing, marquis of Saillants and Claude de Combourcier, lady of Terrail, Ravel and Moissac. Their son, Joseph Durey, 1712-1770, received from his mother, by substitution, the lordship, the castle and the charge of bearing the name and arms of Terrail

which are azure with three golden fleurs-de-lys on the chief of the same. Dubuisson, 1757.

Pierre-François Durey, father of Joseph, took the arms of his parents, Jean Durey (1596-1678) and Etiennette du Blé (1602-1695), quartering them.

Coat of arms: Quarterly, 1 and 4 sable with a argent rock surmounted by a cross of the same, which is of Durey, 2 and 3 azure with three golden wheat sheaves, which is of Blé.
