Georges Pacouil, an artist in the realist tradition, highlights still lifes through a figurative and delicate style. The work depicts a bouquet of flowers in a decorative ceramic vase, accompanied by a terracotta ashtray at its side. The contrast between the colorful flowers and the more sober object such as the ashtray adds a touch of everyday life, reinforcing the intimacy of the scene. The rendering of the flowers is lively and naturalistic, with attention to detail, without falling into hyperrealism. The touches of paint are visible, revealing the texture of the petals and leaves, evidence of a light impressionist approach. The sober background and the reflective surface on which the vase and ashtray rest frame the composition well, highlighting the colors. Types of flowersThe flowers are mainly
