Very beautiful technique of the painter alternating large large flat areas in tasks to create material and texture with more fluid movements to style the movement of clouds in the sky or the wind in the flags. On the left, an oblique work to stylize the characters and the perspective. This is a true work of art, very well done in very precise codes.
