Description

The butterfly is carved in a slightly celadon white jade, it is double-sided and was cut from an unusually very thick jade plate (9mm) which gives the jewel greater solidity. The butterfly is accompanied by pearls, 2 round and 5 parallelepiped (10l) and 4 rings. We think that the whole, connected by silk threads, must have composed a single jewel. The work carried out with the grinding wheel is precise. Antique Chinese jewel from the Qing period. The 5 faceted beads are made of glass paste. Butterfly: 41x33x9mm Rings: 25x4mm Pearls: 7.5mm Polyhedra: 15x7.5mm Good condition, slight wear and very small chips.
