Large Directoire armchair in solid mahogany with a convex belt on the front joining two sheathed legs and a recess in the front and ending with wooden sabots. The rear legs are saber-shaped and set back. The armrests of this armchair rest on two consoles which rest on the top of the legs. These armrests join the straight backrest, each decorated with a volute outgrowth with an acanthus leaf on the top. The seat, in excellent condition, is traditional with straps and balls. It is upholstered in an old fabric used to change according to your taste. ***** Period: Early 19th century Excellent condition.
