A collection of seven watercolour miniatures of documented gems attributed to Thomas Worlidge (c.1700-1766).

English, late 18th century.

Each miniature is set in their original glazed gilt metal mounts and set into a later ebonised wood frame.

The miniatures each measure approximately $6.5/7.4 \times 5.3/5.7$ cm within their gilt metal frames.

The ebonised wooden frame measures 32 x 28cm.
