Chest plate engraved with a hammer decoration. Checkered walnut stock with a beautiful finish and shell sculpture on both sides. Folding trigger that can be fitted into the chest, coming out when the hammer is cocked. Round barrel that can be dismantled by screwing and a key for loading with a forced bullet and inside the smooth barrel. Length: 13.5 cm Length of the barrel alone: 3.5 cm Caliber: 13.
