Perfect condition Ettore Sottsass Born in 1917 in Austria to an Italian father and an Austrian mother, Ettore Sottsass moved to Italy, the family cradle, at a very young age. His approach and commitment are part of a reflection he led at the heart of the Italian avant-garde of the 1960s until the Nuovo Design of the 1980s, when a new generation of designers claimed their spiritual heritage. Navigating between architecture, industrial design and experimental design, Ettore Sottsass occupied a prominent place on the Italian creative scene from the 1950s onwards. A
