With some echoes of early Hollywood, the characters appear dressed in stereotypical Egyptian costumes, while enormous architectures caricaturing the emphasis of the pharaonic close the horizon. Nevertheless, the message prevails, and the pact between Moses and YHWH takes on more meaning than ever in the turbulent Europe of the interwar period, which is experiencing the first episodes of mass aliyah. - Dimensions of the image without frame: 40 x 30 cm / 48 x 37 cm with magnificent frame.
