A blue and white Kraak 'bird of prey' dish. China, Ming dynasty, Wanli period, c. 1595-1610.

The dish in the shape of a chrysanthemum, the cavetto moulded in double-tiered scallops, decorated in the center with an underglaze blue decoration of a bird of prey in a natural landscape.
