Brass frame. Rocket molded in relief of rows of scales. Oval knob without decoration. Box cruise from which a guard branch and two steel quillons emerge, the quillons end with a brass olive. The cruise ends in the lower part with a trapezoidal shape stamped in relief of the Phrygian cap.

Rustic double-edged blade with obtuse tip, length 48 cm, heel width 4 cm.

Brass sheath with wooden mattress pad covered with fine scarlet sheet (wear and dirt).

A bar serving as a bracelet to fix the belièr rings (diameter 2.5 cm, thickness 3 mm) placed
