Description

Dominant visual elements: Color: Dark blue dominates, creating a nocturnal and mysterious atmosphere. Yellow and red bring touches of warmth and movement. Shapes: Vertical lines create a feeling of rhythm and stability. Birds in flight suggest freedom and elevation. The arc shape evokes a lyre or harp, a musical instrument associated with poetry and divinity. Symbols: Birds: Universal symbols of freedom, spirit and messengers between the worlds. Stars: Represent the divine, infinity and knowledge. The lyre/harp: Associated with music, poetry and the muses in Greek mythology. Charles Marcel Jean Picart Le Doux, born January 31, 1902 in the 6th arrondissement of Paris and died May 7, 1982 in Venice, is a French painter and tapestry artist of the contemporary tapestry revival.
