Description

AQUAMANILE (also called Lavabo, ladle or oscillating fountain) in lenticular pewter with a flared throat with two side spillways with stylized bird heads, fitted with a swinging wrought iron bracket complete with its bail.

Width: 31.6 cm.

Height at the throat: 11.5 cm.

ALSACE (Haguenau?), First half of the 18th century

Object in good condition, a local filling at the base, almost invisible on the outside, is however reported.

Usually in bronze or cast brass, this extremely rare aquamanile in the pewter material is in all respects identical to another copy bearing an Alsatian master's mark attributed to Johannes
