Veterinarian's flame The flame, the most commonly used instrument in the practice of veterinary bloodletting, is formed of a steel rod about ten centimeters long topped with a sharp triangle, accompanied by other tools for veterinary use: a bleeding lancet, a curved scalpel and a hoof scraper, an instrument used to clean the feet.
