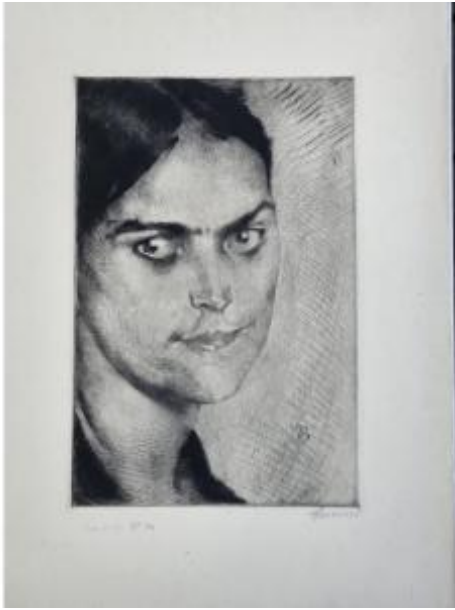




Claire, Engraving By Albert Besnard, 1887

Description

Albert Besnard, painter, decorator and engraver; His parents were Louis Adolphe Besnard, a history painter and student of Ingres, and Louise Pauline Vaillant, a renowned miniaturist and student of Lizinska de Mirbel. Albert Besnard studied with Jean-François Brémond and was admitted on March 20, 1866 to the École des Beaux-Arts in Paris, in the studios of Alexandre Cabanel and Sébastien Cornu. In 1874, he won the Grand Prix de Rome with his composition *La Mort de Timophane, tyran de Corinthe...* No. 64 at Delteil, 53 at Coppier, our engraving is from the 4th state. It is printed on a strong fibrous vellum which gives the impression of a slight epidermage on the face. Signed lower right, annotated lower left: printed at 75, No. 20. A chisel mark in the lower margin on the right.
