Albert Besnard, painter, decorator and engraver; His parents were Louis Adolphe Besnard, a history painter and student of Ingres, and Louise Pauline Vaillant, a renowned miniaturist and student of Lizinska de Mirbel. Albert Besnard studied with Jean-François Brémond and was admitted on March 20, 1866 to the École des Beaux-Arts in Paris, in the studios of Alexandre Cabanel and Sébastien-Léon Cornu. In 1874, he won the Grand Prix de Rome with his composition *La Mort de Timophane, tyran de Corinthe...* No. 107 at Delteil and 97 at Coppier. 3rd state, the cut plate measures only 225mm and 164 in height with the letter. In the bottom margin we read: PABesnard pinx Salon du Champs de Mars Horse market (Algiers area) Etching by the artist Gazette des Beaux-Arts Imp.A.Clément.
