Born in Lille, Robert Béat first worked with his father Paul Béat, from whom he quickly emancipated himself. Painter, but also decorator like his father, he created many sets, frescoes for churches, trompe-l'oeil, theater sets, sets for wallpapers, ... First a landscape painter, he soon devoted himself to portraiture with jubilation. During his stays in Brittany or the Basque Country, he executed many portraits, powerful and colorful. In Brittany, his touch is broad, thick, with a palette using all the shades of
