Description

Albert Besnard, painter, decorator and engraver; His parents were Louis Adolphe Besnard, a history painter and student of Ingres, and Louise Pauline Vaillant, a renowned miniaturist and student of Lizinska de Mirbel. Albert Besnard studied with Jean-François Brémond and was admitted on March 20, 1866 to the École des Beaux-Arts in Paris, in the studios of Alexandre Cabanel and Sébastien-Louis Cornu. In 1874, he won the Grand Prix de Rome with his composition *La Mort de Timophane, tyran de Corinthe...* No. 18 at Delteil and 17 at Coppier. Our plate is a 2nd state, signed lower right and annotated lower left: printed at 75, No. 11.
