Bronze sculpture from the 19th century representing a young winner by Adrien Étienne Gaudez. Famous sculptor from the 19th century 1845 to 1902, he was a great creator of monuments following the war of 1870. He is represented in many French museums. Here is a very beautiful bronze with a magnificent original patina representing a young athlete, an allegory of victory bearing on the base a cartouche with the words Hors concours, Le Vainqueur. Presence of a medallion with an inscription, the jury of 1905 to its president L Carnoy. Very interesting large piece, height 64 cm, dynamic in its attitude and remarkable for the quality of the work visible in the details and the expression of the face.
