On the sides of the bridge, on the two banks of the canal, the famous palaces of the City face each other in line, described minutely and with extreme skill in all the architectural details, some in full light and others in shadow.The

luminescent green tone of the canal waters contrasts with the splendid blue sky. The great pictorial skills of the Author are evident both in the depiction of the buildings and in the rendering of the figures on the typical boats. It is a splendid 19th century canvas that, in addition to standing out for the evident beauty of the subject, masterfully executed, stands out for its rarity and is proposed not only as an excellent furnishing but also as a valid investment. In fact, Coen's works obtain excellent results at auction and are particularly appreciated by collectors of 19th century painting.
