Description:Botticino marble carved. This pair of basins is a work of the Grand Tour by reproducing those of large size of the ancient Roman period.Moreover and rarely in pairs, the cups in centerpieces are never thus organized in such a design of basin. The Grand Tour was an authentic cultural journey before the letter and a small industry of objects was born from it. At the time, the spirit of beauty predominated over authenticity hence the objects in reduction allowing to easily bring back a witness of the last discovery of excavations, as well as the spirit of the beauty of Ancient Art.Each basin is placed on a base with curved pyramid coffers. The belly has the base widened in gadroons as for a Medici vase. The edge is encircled with very elegant volutes in ribbons tied in four parts and joining in
