Much later, the fourteen blocks of stone were found in the basements of the Joubert publishing house. With the owner's permission, they were reprinted in 1978 at the Atelier Murlot in Paris and published by Editions AC Mazo & Cie. After this edition, the stones were postmarked and deposited in the Cabinet des Estampes of the Bibliothèque Nationale.
